





Service Area Map





Healthcare System in Thailand














Financial Performance vs Patient Growth





Revenue Breakdown 2016-2020




Revenue Breakdown by Customer Group










SSO – Registered Member (Average)

Revenue Breakdown by Branch: 3 months






Major contributors - CH3, CH9, CH11 = 82.6% (3Q20 = 76.1%)

Revenue Breakdown by Branch: 9 months









OPD Utilization Rate








Unit: Beds-Day







