### Service Area Map










### Financial Performance vs Patient Growth





### Revenue Breakdown 2017-2021




#### **Revenue Breakdown by Customer Group**







### Revenue Breakdown by Branch: 3 months



### Revenue Breakdown by Branch: 12 months









### **OPD Utilization Rate**




